A TROWBRIDGE councillor has called for a 20mph speed limit outside Walwayne Court School following several near-misses.

Cllr Tom Bazan asked for Brook Road to become a 20mph zone at Tuesday's town and development committee meeting.

"Earlier this year, pupils at the school staged a demonstration, warning drivers to not speed and double park outside the school," he said.

His request has gone to the community area transport group to be reviewed.
