**Term 3**  
**Year 4 – Serotine Bats**

**English**

We will be reading *King of the Cloud Forests* by Michael Morpurgo.



In our writing we will be learning to:

- Write a diary entry
- Write a fiction text
- Write an explanation text

**Maths**

We will be learning to:

- Multiply and divide by 6,7,9,11 and 12.
- We will begin to understand mathematical vocabulary including quotient in relation to division.
- We will learn how to calculate multiplication equations using the multiplication facts that we know.
- We will understand the difference between sharing and grouping.
- We will understand the commutative law in multiplication.

**Spelling/Phonics**

We will be practising our statutory words for Year 3 & 4, as well as words that link to our spelling rules.



**Misty Mountain, Winding River**  
**(Geography focus)**

In the Misty Mountain, Winding River project, we will learn about the characteristics and physical processes of rivers, including how they shape the landscape over time, their significance around the world and the impact of flooding. We will learn how to use the eight points of a compass, four and six-figure grid references, symbols and a key to locate and plot geographical places and features on a map, as well as how contour lines are used to show the topography of an area. We will have the opportunity to learn about the stages of the water cycle and about mountains and their different formations, studying mountain ranges in the United Kingdom and around the world. We will also learn about habitats and how human and natural influences can have an impact on the environment.

**Science**

In science we will be learning about the water cycle and relating this to our geography learning.

**Art**

We will be creating a mixed media picture, developing our understanding of texture and pattern, whilst using traditional aboriginal art methods.

**DT**

We will form a mountain, showing the river running from source to mouth and indicating where processes of the water cycle take place.

**Music**

All children will be using Charanga as their learning platform for music this term. Pupils will be sent individual login details (similar to TT Rock Stars). Tasks will be set for the children to work on at home and Mrs Andrews will be able to look at your work. Have fun!
