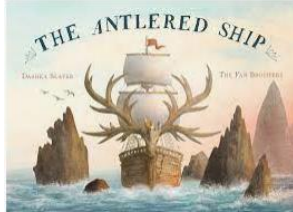


English

In our writing we will be learning to

- Write a coastal description.
- Write an adventure narrative about sea rescue.
- Write a non-chronological coastline report.

Maths

In maths, we will be revisiting and consolidating our multiplication and division methods, using numbers up to 100.

We will also be looking fractions and developing our skills in reasoning and word problems.

Spelling/Phonics/Grammar.

- Apostrophes for contraction.
- Revisiting all spelling patterns taught.



Head into term 6 and get ready to relax by the Great British Sea Side!

In the Coastline project, your child will use maps to learn about the location of the world's seas and oceans and keys to learn about map symbols. They will also find out about the directions on a compass. They will learn about the human and physical features of a coastline, including the effects of erosion and how to stay safe when visiting the coast. They will have the opportunity to learn about the work of the RNLI, what happened to the SS *Rohilla* and about the coastal town of Whitby, including how Captain Cook is linked to the town. They will research the tourism industry and consider what features make a place a successful tourist destination.

Science

We will be developing our scientific understanding by investigating which materials float and why they are suitable to use in boat building.

Art/DT

In art, we will be creating a mixed media print, developing our printing skills of the sea.

In DT, we will develop our designing and fine tuning our building skills to investigate building a beach hut.

Geography

We will be learning to identify both human and physical features of the coastline, whilst developing our geographical skills with map work.

PE

We will be preparing for sports day. We will develop an effective running technique as well as learning about being a good sports person and accepting and celebrating winners.

History

In history, we will be learning about Whitby in the past and present, as well as Captain Cook.

Music

In music, we will be learning sea shanties! We will also be developing our listening and performance skills.
