

English

We will be reading *Who let the gods out?* by Maz Evans



In our writing we will be learning to:

Create our own Greek myths
Write a biography of a significant figure
Produce a report about how the Ancient Greeks influenced modern life

Maths

We will be completing our learning about fractions and moving on to look at decimals, including multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000.

Spelling

We will be using dictionaries to help check the spelling and meaning of words that begin with the same first three or four letters. We will also be practising problem suffixes, such as "-ies" and "-ous".

Music

In music this term, pupils will learn about Samba Music through performing and composing. They will perform simple patterns as a whole class as well as composing some simple riffs in smaller groups.



Beast Creator

In the Groundbreaking Greeks project, your child will learn about different periods of Greek history, exploring the earliest civilisations, the Dark Age and the Archaic and Classical periods. They will understand how the geography of Greece affected the development of city-states and explore Athens, learning about the structure of the government and society. They will get to know some of the most significant Athenians and understand why Greek art, culture, architecture, philosophy, medicine and mathematics were so significant.

Design & Technology

We will design and make framed structures, using real-life examples such as gazebos, bus shelters and adventure play equipment.

Art

Inspired by the painting, Claude-Joseph Vernet, 'A Shipwreck in Stormy Seas', art will be a child led project exploring a variety of visual elements in art.

Geography

We will use aerial photography to understand where Greece is in the world and how the geography affected the development of city-states.

PHSE

We will be preparing for transition to secondary school, including visits to some of our local schools. We will continue to learn about relationships and how to maintain successful relationships online and in person.

PE

In P.E. this term, we will be developing our fundamental and preparing for Sports Day. We will also be learning about showing sportsmanship; accepting and celebrating winners and respecting the rules.

French

We will be learning about classroom items, using our knowledge of "j'ai/je n'ai pas" to say what we have and don't have.

Computing

We will use physical computing to explore the concept of selection in programming through the use of the Crumble programming environment.

RE

We will learn how Christians show commitment to God. We will learn how they attend church and take part in communion to show their commitment.
