
What we will learn

This term the children will begin to learn about different types of transport and to understand that it can take us from one place to another. We will learn about public transport and that we need to buy tickets to travel on public transport.

We will explore and draw maps and talk about human features such as parks, train stations, bus station etc. and they will also be exposed to the language of physical features such as river, hill, forest and beach.

The children will experience ways to keep themselves safe when travelling and on public transport such as putting on a seat belt on the minibus, keeping tickets safe, standing behind the yellow line at the train station, keeping money in a wallet/purse and only speaking to 'safe' adults.







Our trip next term will involve the different modes of transport that we will be learning about. We intend on taking the children on a bus and a train and spending time at Alexandra Park in Bath as we look at the train station and bus station views as well as the city from the park ... I wonder what views we will see?







Our project related vocabulary


Nouns: map, town, city, road, library, park, train station, bus station, harbour, human features, physical features, river, hill, forest, beach, safe, help, danger, money, rules
